Memorandum of Agreement to Establish A Postsecondary 2 + 2 Cooperative Progression Program Between Southeastern Louisiana University and Baton Rouge Community College Business

Southeastern Louisiana University and Baton Rouge Community College, wishing to establish a cooperative arrangement to encourage timely student progression and graduation, agree to provide a seamless transition for students identifying their intent to pursue a bachelor's degree upon completion of their associate degree.

Students of Baton Rouge Community College in the Associate in General Studies with a Business Concentration or the Associate of Science in Business degree program who declare their intent to pursue the Bachelor of Arts in general business, management or marketing, or the Bachelor of Science degree in accounting or finance, at Southeastern Louisiana University's College of Business will be:

- a) Pre-admitted to Southeastern Louisiana University. The preadmission will be without charge. Formal admission into Southeastern must occur within five years of the intent to participate and is predicated on the successful completion of Baton Rouge Community College's Associate in General Studies with a Business Concentration or the Associate of Science in Business degree program with a 2.0 cumulative GPA, and receipt of immunization documentation.
- b) Assigned a faculty advisor in the College of Business at Southeastern for assistance with their intended fields of study at Southeastern Louisiana University. Files will be kept by Southeastern Louisiana University on these students and their progression tracked.
- c) Admitted to Southeastern Louisiana University as a junior upon successful completion of the Baton Rouge Community College Associate degree in General Studies with a Business Concentration or the Associate of Science in Business degree program.
- d) Positioned to maximize credit transferability by pursing a pre-approved program of study.
- e) Admitted to Southeastern Louisiana University using the catalogue of record coinciding with their commitment to enter this 2+2 program. Maintenance of a catalogue of record is dependent upon a student completing the Baton Rouge Community College Associate in General Studies with a Business Concentration or the Associate of Science in Business degree program and entering Southeastern Louisiana University within five years of his/her declaration to enter the program. A period of non-enrollment exceeding two semesters, including summer, will necessitate using the most current catalog.

For its part, Southeastern Louisiana University will:

- a) Deliver curriculum information sheets to Baton Rouge Community College for each degree program in business.
- b) Develop in conjunction with Baton Rouge Community College an "Intent to Participate" form to expedite program progression.
- c) Encourage program participants to continue progression in the program so that they might complete the Associate in General Studies with a Business Concentration or the Associate of Science in Business degree program and progress to the Bachelor's program in a timely manner.
- d) Provide advisors to program participants. Advisors will be available through phone and on-line consultation, as well as through on-site appointments.
- e) Develop a process to award one one-semester \$500 scholarship each fall to a successful, participating student at the point of enrolling in Southeastern's College of Business.

For its part, Baton Rouge Community College will:

- a) Maintain timely files related to the progression of their students in this program.
- b) Encourage students to pursue the 2 + 2 program and progress in a timely manner.
- c) Provide Southeastern Louisiana University with participating students' transcripts, per student approval, each semester to facilitate the timely recording of student data at Southeastern and allow for timely advising.
- d) Develop, with Southeastern representatives, an "Intent to Participate" form that will allow for easy record transferability and data sharing that is in compliance with FERPA.
- e) Meet periodically with Southeastern representatives to assess program progress.
- f) Communicate degree program changes to Southeastern in a timely manner.
- g) Promote the program in the Baton Rouge Community College service area.

Additional Information:

- 1. Southeastern Louisiana University and Baton Rouge Community College enter into this agreement in a joint effort to promote degree program progression and easy transferability between two and four year degree programs in business.
- 2. This agreement is effective upon signing. Either party may terminate the agreement through a written notice to the other party 90 days prior to the date of termination. Should the agreement be discontinued, students who declared their intent to participate will be allowed to progress through the program and complete it within three years.
- 3. Both parties will periodically assess the program for effectiveness and impact and share the outcome of that assessment for planning purposes.
- 4. Changes to this agreement may be made at any time, with the express agreement of the chief academic officers of each campus.

5. Spreadsheets indicating the current Associate in General Studies with a Business Concentration and the Associate of Science in Business degree programs at Baton Rouge Community College and the transferability of these degrees' credits to bachelors' degrees in business at Southeastern Louisiana University are attached and made a part of this agreement.
