Grade Point Average Requirements after completing the Associate of Science in Business:

1. Students with an overall grade point average of 3.0 as well as a grade point average of 2.50 in Business Courses will be eligible for transfer into the following Business degree programs at Louisiana State University:
  - a. Bachelor of Science in Accounting
  - b. Bachelor of Science in Finance
  - c. Bachelor of Science in Management
  - d. Bachelor of Science in Marketing
  
2. Students with an overall grade point average of 2.50 as well as a grade point average of 2.00 in Business Courses will be eligible for transfer into the following Business degree programs at Louisiana State University:
  - a. Bachelor of Science in Economics
  - b. Bachelor of Science in International Trade and Finance
  - c. Bachelor of Science in Information Systems and Decision Sciences
  - d. Bachelor of Science in General Business
  
3. "C's" or higher are required in all business courses. "C's" or higher are also required in ENGL 101 & 102 and MATH 101/110 & 201 and ECON 201 & 202.
