#### GLOSSARY:

<u>Degree/Credential-Seeking Student:</u> a student enrolled in a program that leads to a Certificate, Technical Diploma, or Associate Degree.

First-Time Student: a student entering BRCC who has never attended any college or university previously.

Transferring-In Student: a student entering BRCC with prior credit earned from another college or university.

Full-Time Student: a student enrolled in twelve or more credit hours.

Part-Time Student: a student enrolled in less than twelve credit hours.

<u>Persistence</u>: continued enrollment from one semester to the next, regardless of student type.

Retention: measure of how many students entering the College for the first time returned the next Spring or Fall semester OR graduated and left.
