Policy Statement

In accordance with R.S. 17.3352, and subject to the Board of Supervisors approval, BRCC is authorized to grant an Honorary Associate of Arts in Humane Letters to any individual who has made substantial achievements in their respective field of endeavor. All degrees, whether honorary or earned, shall be conferred by vote of the LCTCS Board upon the recommendation of the BRCC Chancellor and Chief Academic Officer.

Honorary degrees shall not be granted in a specific discipline and shall not be printed in a manner to be mistaken as an earned degree granted by BRCC. Two categories of individuals are excluded from receiving honorary degrees: (1) faculty or staff members currently employed at BRCC, (2) Louisiana elected and/or appointed officials in office at the time of selection and conferral. BRCC may award a maximum of two honorary degrees per academic year.
