Policy Statement

Credit will be accepted from a regionally accredited college or university. Grades awarded for any and all transfer credits are not calculated as part of the BRCC institutional grade point average, but are included in the student's overall grade point average. Accepted credits will be posted to the official transcript with the designation of "T" for transfer. Only grades of "C" or better will be considered for transfer credit; exceptions can be given by the Dean of the student's program of study. A "C" is the lowest acceptable transfer grade for English Composition 101 and 102 and College Algebra (MATH 101 and MATH 110).
