Policy Statement

Purpose

This policy establishes the guidelines students considering any monetary referendum.

Scope

This policy applies to students.

Definition

A referendum is the practice or principle of submitting to popular vote a measure passed on or proposed by a legislative body.

Policy

The policy of BRCC is to ensure that students considering any monetary referendum must request approval from the Chancellor by adhering to the following:

- Explanation of the reason for the referendum;
- Exact language of the referendum as it will appear on the ballot;
- Explanation of efforts to educate students on the referendum issue;
- Fiscal impact of the referendum;
- Appeal process;
- Approval by the Executive Director of Student Services and the Vice Chancellor for Enrollment Management & Student Support prior to submitting to the Chancellor's Office; and
- Approval of the Chancellor indicating support of the item.
