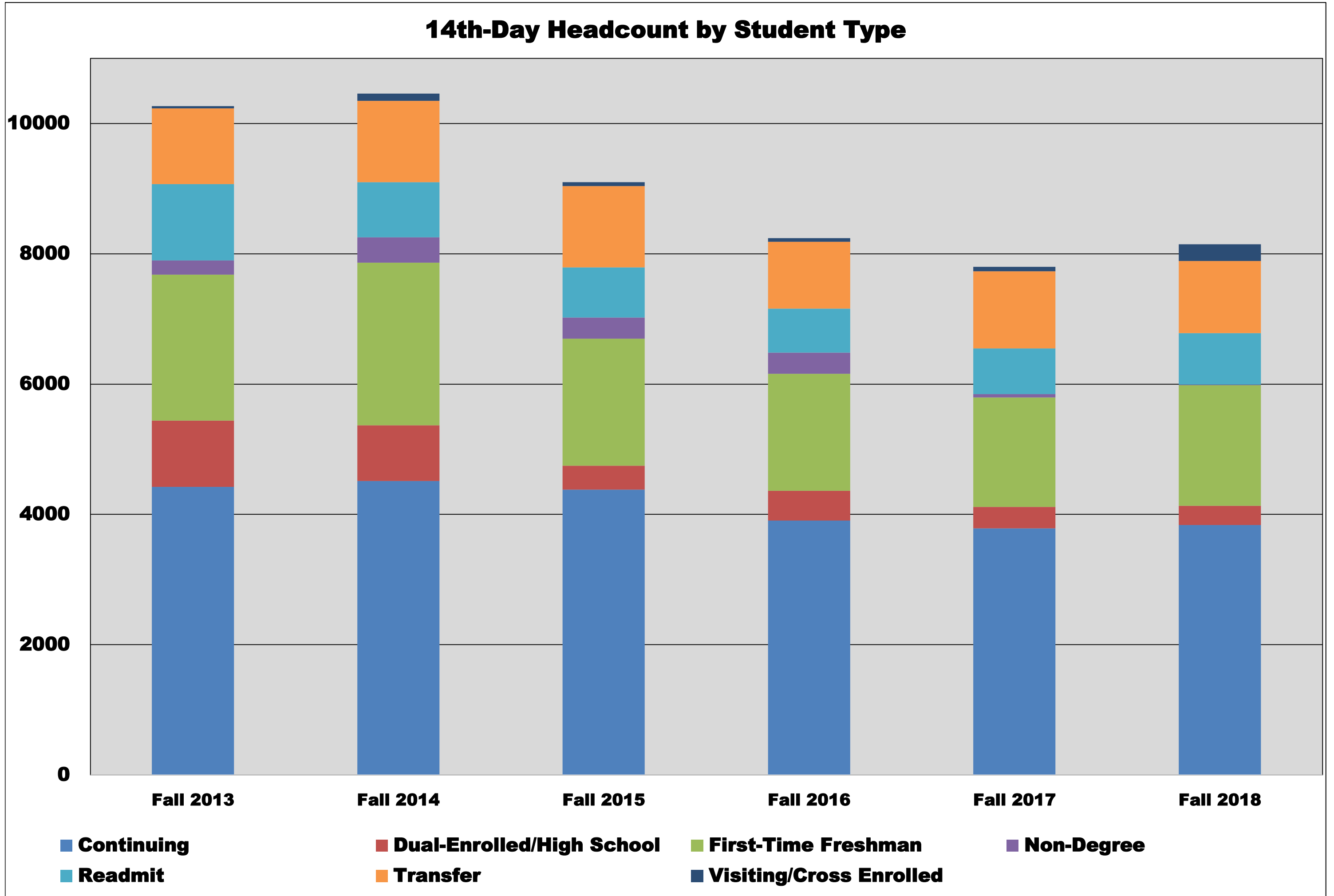

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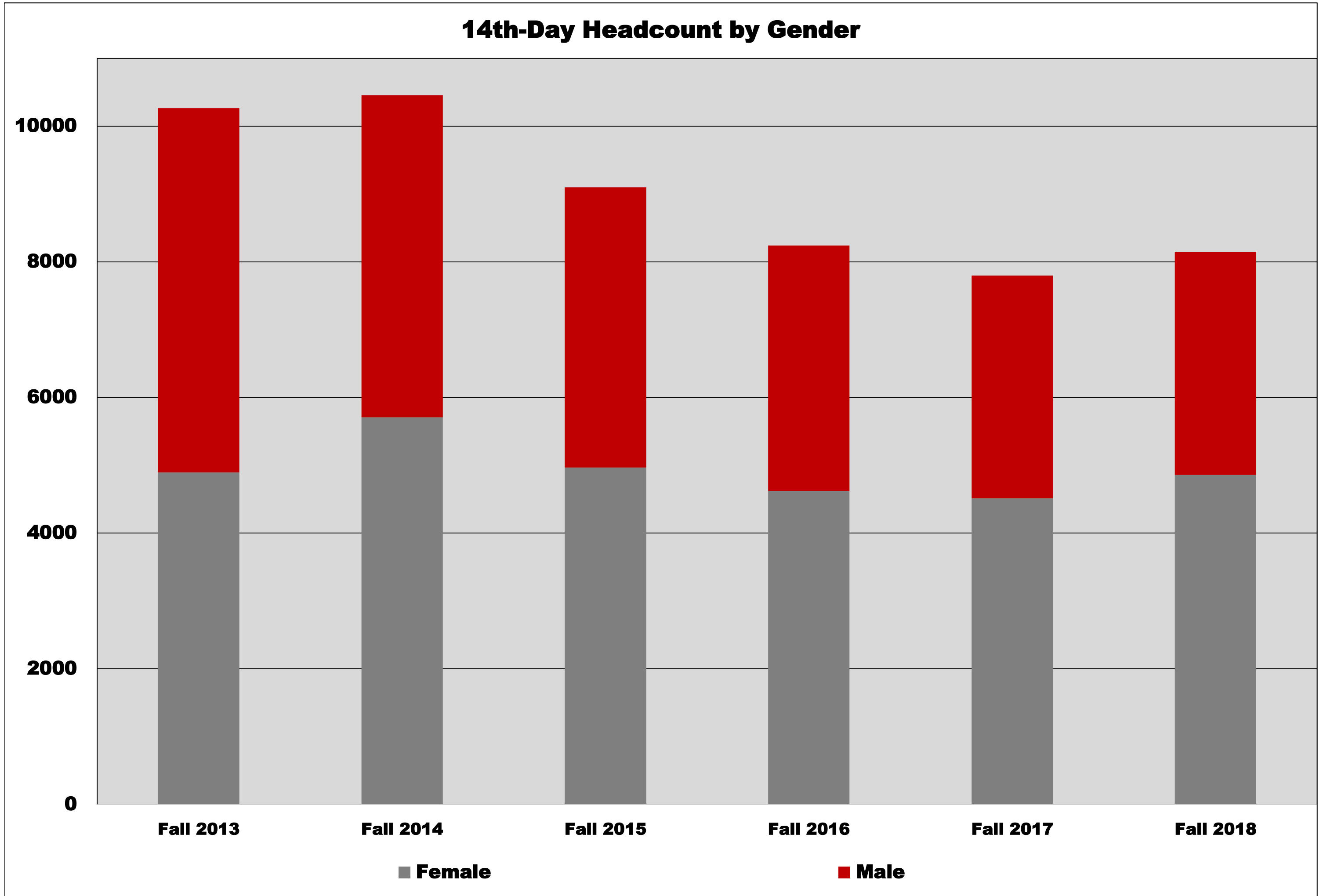
Fall Semester 2013-2018 14th-Day Headcount by Student Type

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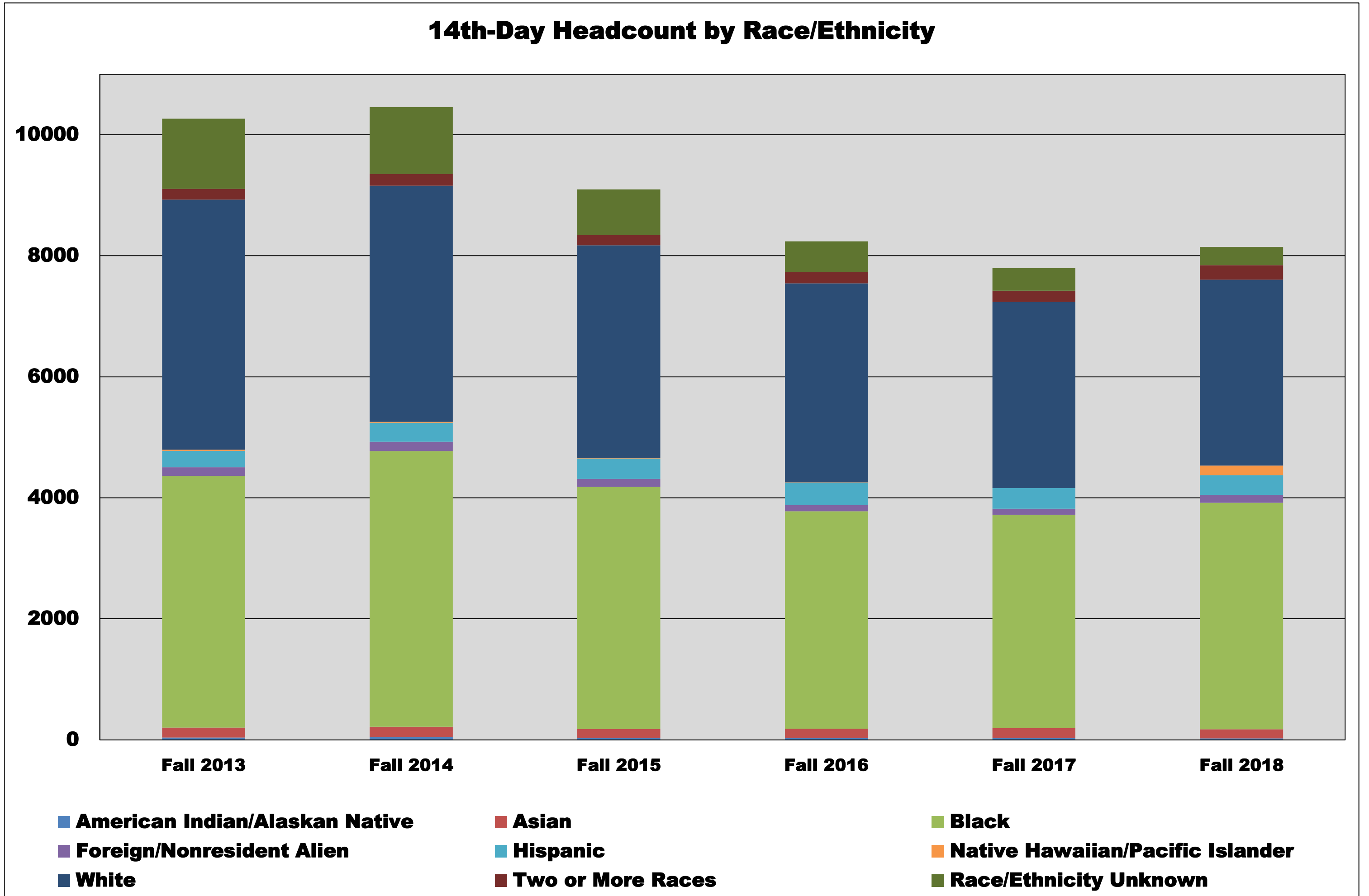
Fall Semester 2013-2018 14th-Day Headcount by Gender

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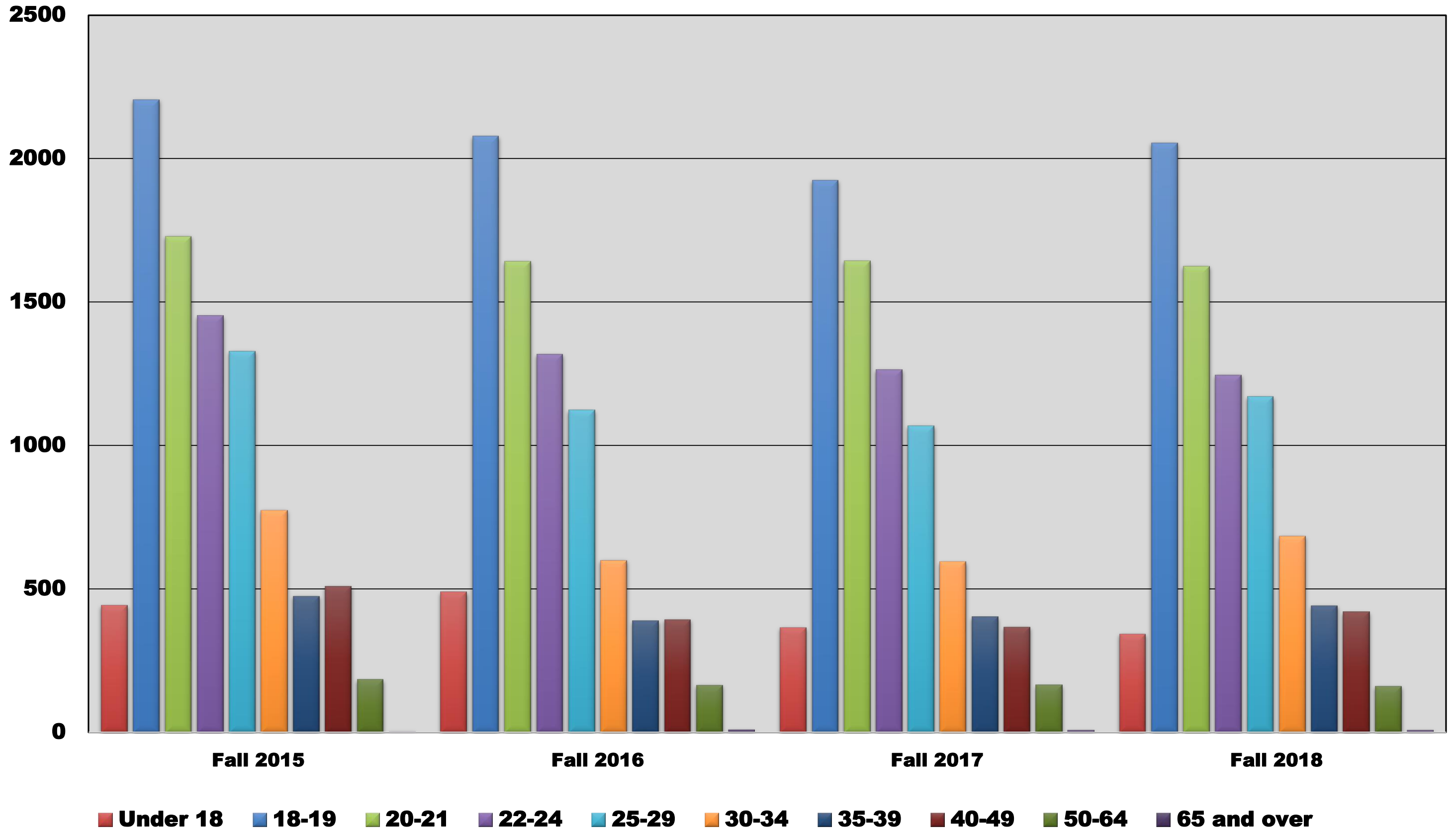

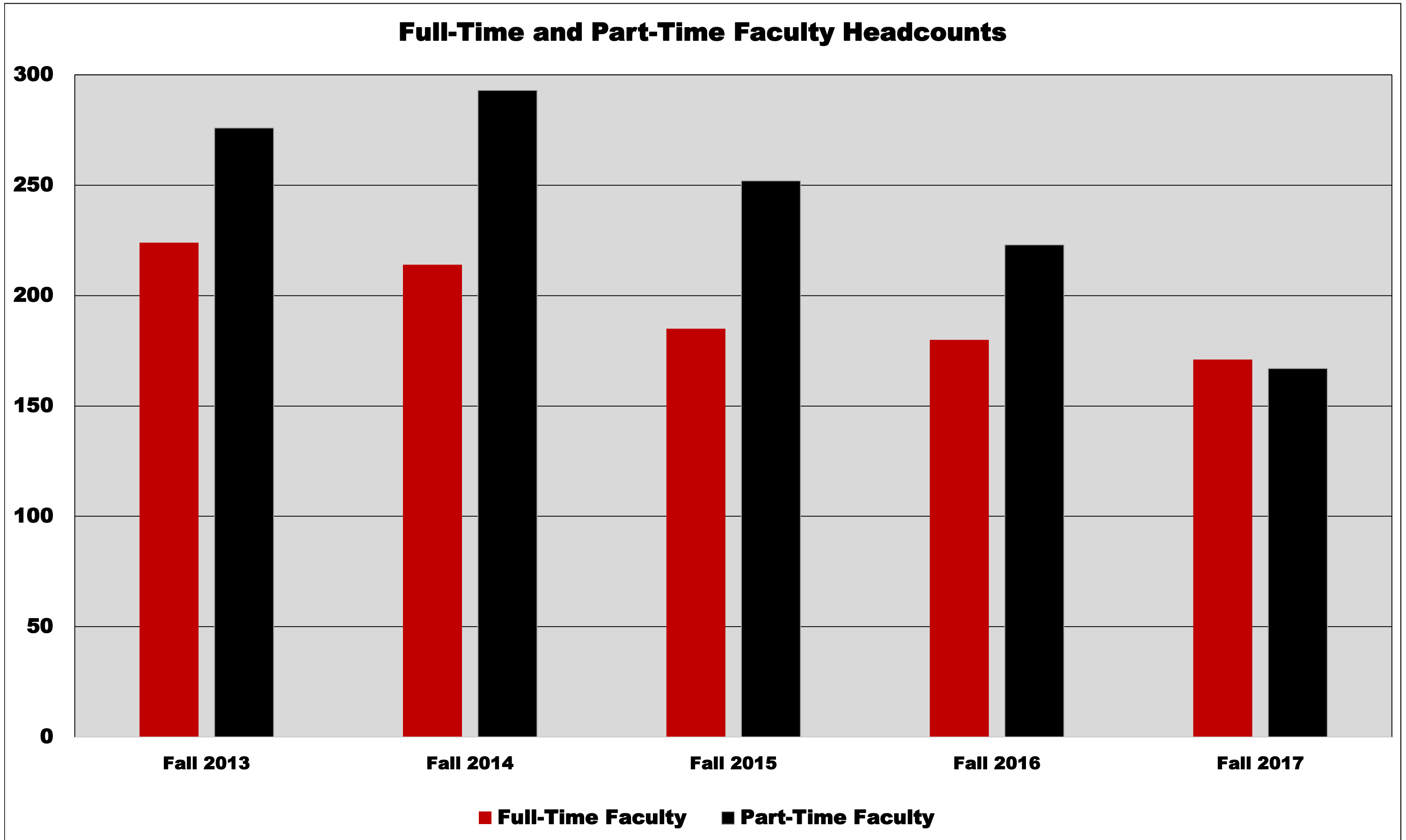

Fall Semester 2013-2017 Full-Time and Part-Time Faculty Headcounts

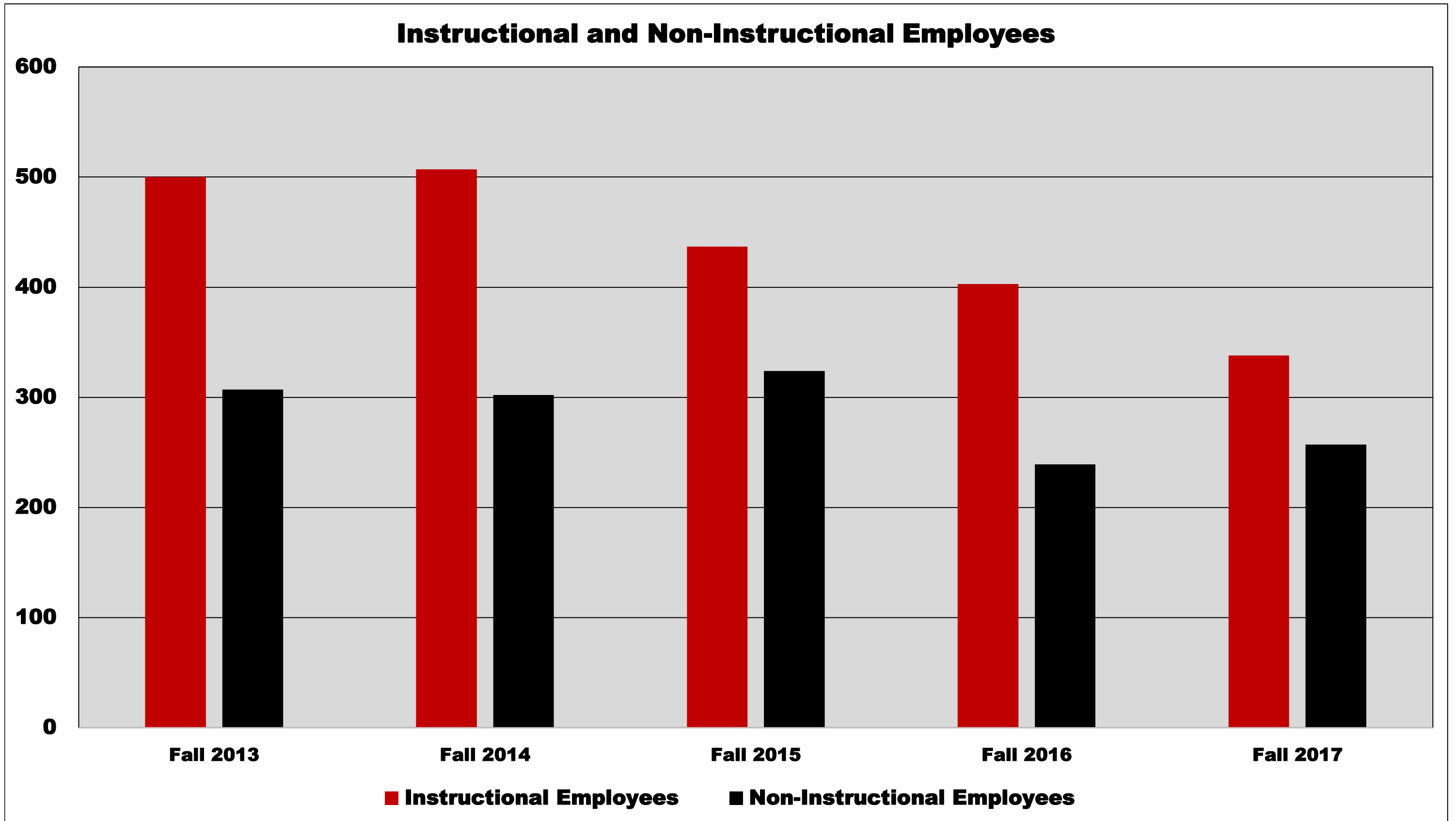
