Grade Point Average Requirements after completing the Associate of Science in Business:

1. Students with cumulative and LSU grade point averages of 3.0 as well as a grade point average of 2.5 (cumulative and LSU) in Business Courses will be eligible for transfer into the following Business degree programs at Louisiana State University:
 - a. Bachelor of Science in Accounting
 - b. Bachelor of Science in Finance

2. Students with cumulative and LSU averages of 2.6 as well as a grade point average of 2.3 (cumulative and LSU) in Business Courses will be eligible for transfer into the following Business degree programs at Louisiana State University:
 - a. Bachelor of Science in Economics
 - b. Bachelor of Science in General Business
 - c. Bachelor of Science in International Trade and Finance
 - d. Bachelor of Science in Information Systems and Decision Sciences
 - e. Bachelor of Science in Management
 - f. Bachelor of Science in Marketing

3. "C's" or higher are required in all business courses. "C's" or higher are also required in ENGL 1013 & 1023 and MATH 1113/1213 & 2103 and ECON 2213 & 2223.
