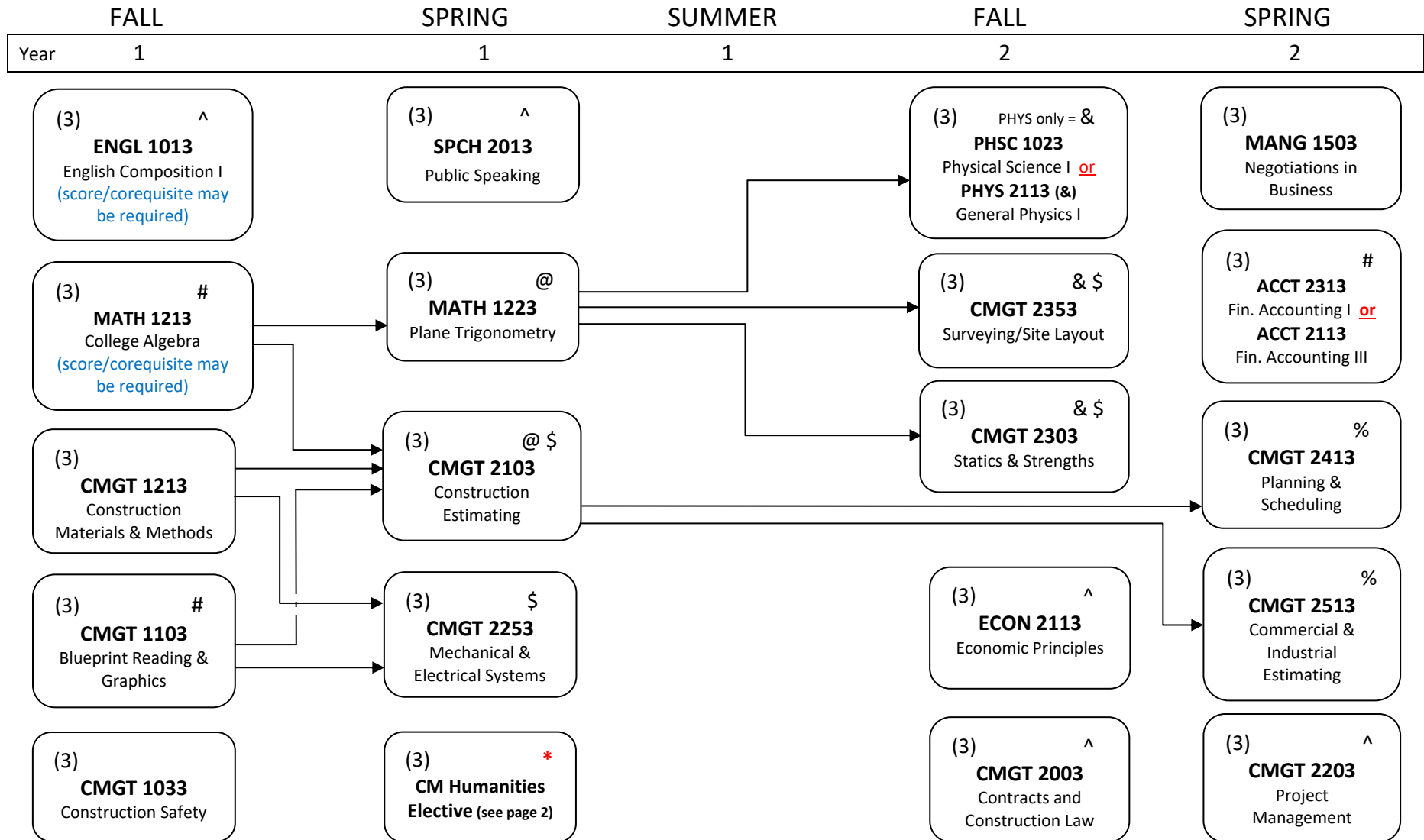


CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AAS Degree – Course Flowchart Baton Rouge Community College
