- Applications are available each academic year in the fall semester ONLY.

- Entry into the LPN-RN program is **COMPETITIVE. MEETING THE MINIMUM PREREQUISITES AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS DOES NOT GUARANTEE ACCEPTANCE INTO THE PROGRAM.**
- Entrance is determined by applicants' GPA in the 27 credit hours of prerequisites courses, ATI TEAS exam scores, and challenge exam scores.

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- The application deadline published on this application **WILL NOT BE EXTENDED.**
- You must print and complete the one-page application (pg. 7) and submit it in person to the front lobby of Frazier Building or you may mail the application – it must be **RECEIVED BY NOVEMBER 27TH – NOT POSTMARKED NOVEMBER 27TH. BE SURE TO ALLOW TIME FOR POSTAL DELIVERY!**

- Applications will not be accepted by email, fax, or phone IN PERSON OR POSTAL MAIL ONLY.
- The TEAS exam can be taken remotely through ATI (online from your home) or through the BRCC Testing Center <u>https://www.mybrcc.edu/testingcenter/index.php</u>. If you have previously taken the TEAS exam within the last five years and scored a 65% or better that score can be used. You will need to print and attach that score to your application.
- Late or incomplete applications want be accepted nor will incomplete applications be held. All required information and a photograph must accompany the application for it to be accepted.
- COURSE WORK THAT WAS TAKEN AT OTHER INSTITUTION(S) AND VISIBLE ON YOUR BRCC TRANSCRIPT, YOU NEED ONLY TO SUBMIT ONE PRINTED UNOFFICIAL BRCC TRANSCRIPT ONLY. IF COURSE WORK FROM OTHER INSTITUTION(S) ARE NOT VISIBLE, YOU MUST SUBMIT TWO (2) OFFICIAL PRINTED TRANSCRIPTS FROM THOSE INSTITUTIONS.
- **TRANSCRIPTS FROM OTHER COLLEGES MUST BE OFFICIAL.** If necessary, you may need to contact the issuing college to access their transcript services.
- Official transcripts may require a few days to a week or more to be issued and may require a payment. Do this early **the application deadline is firm**
- Do not wait until the last days of the application period to resolve any transcript issues from BRCC or other institutions. LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- You must attach a **2 INCH X 2 INCH COLOR PHOTO** to the application.

GENERAL INFORMATION

In order to be eligible for admission to the LPN-RN Entry Track, the applicant must first be admitted to Baton Rouge Community College (BRCC). The college application is available from the Office of Enrollment Services, or online at http://www.mybrcc.edu. The LPN-RN Entry Track application and all supporting documents must be received by the designated deadlines. Applicants will not be considered for admittance to the ASN program until all required documents have been submitted and the applicant's file is complete. A copy of the application and all supporting documents should be retained by the applicant since the program will not return the original application or any supporting documents. All correspondence will be sent to the applicant's permanent address and/or BRCC e-mail. Admission to the LPN-RN Entry Track Program is competitive and will be based on the following criteria: 1) GPA in 27 credit hours of prerequisite courses, 2) student's scores on the nursing admission exams.

It is important to note that meeting minimum admission requirements does not guarantee admission to the program.

APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP 1 BATON ROUGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS-In order to be considered for admission to the ASN program, you must be admitted to Baton Rouge Community College. If you are not already a BRCC student, you must complete the BRCC application and submit all required documentation to Enrollment Services.

STEP 2 LPN-RN Entry Track - ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicants must have a GPA of 2.8 or higher in the required 27 credit hours of prerequisite courses
- 2. Applicants must have a grade of "C" or higher in the required 27 credit hours of prerequisite courses

Applicants MUST submit transcripts with their application. <u>If all coursework is posted on your BRCC transcript in LOLA, you can print and submit one unofficial BRCC transcript with your application. If you completed coursework at another institution, and your credits are not posted on your BRCC transcript, YOU MUST SUBMIT 2 OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM EACH SCHOOL YOU ATTENDED.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT:

- Electronic transcripts
- Unofficial transcripts from any school other than BRCC
- Opened transcripts (Official transcript must be in a sealed envelope with the registrar's stamp)

The steps for viewing your transcripts in LOLA:

- Select the Student Tab
- o Select View Transcript in the Academic Links section

- 4. Applicants must attach a (2"x2" color photo) to their application NO EXCEPTIONS
- 5. Applicants must take and pass ATI **TEAS Exam** with a minimum score of 65%.
 - a. If you have completed the TEAS exam at another testing site or college those scores can be used and you must submit your score report with your application. Scores remain valid for 5 years.
- 6. Applicants must hold an unencumbered license as a practical nurse in the State of Louisiana. * Verification of licensure is required with the application. Verification can be obtained on the LSBPNE Website www.lsbpne.com
- 7. Applicants must submit their completed and signed LPN/RN application to the collection box at the Frazier building front lobby by Monday, November 27th at 12:00 pm or through postal mail. Remember the application must be RECEIVED by MONDAY, NOVEMBER 27th, so allow time for postal delivery. - 8. Application must successfully pass the TEAS Exam with a 65% or better before being able to take the challenge exams.
- 9. Applicants must successfully pass the Nursing Fundamentals Challenge Exam <u>and</u> the Adult Nursing I Challenge Exam. A score of 850 on both exams. Applicants can only take these exams once per admission cycle.
- LPN applicants who pass <u>both</u> challenge exams are eligible, but not guaranteed admission, for matriculation into NURS 2124: Mental Health Nursing. NURS 2124 is offered in the summer <u>if there are a sufficient number of students admitted to the</u> <u>program to offer the course. If not, students admitted to the program will take NURS 2124 fall 2024.</u>
- 11. Applicants admitted to the program must complete a PLA form to receive college credit for both the Nursing Fundamentals and Adult Nursing I. Administration handles the completing of this form after applicant's admission to the program.
- 12. If the LPN-RN applicant does not pass one of the challenge exams they will have the option of applying to the Generic TRACK. <u>Applications must be submitted immediately after testing.</u>

STEP 3 SELECTION NOTIFICATIONS

- 1. <u>All</u> applicants are notified of admission status (Admitted or Denied) the week after spring break.
- 2. Applicants admitted to the nursing program will receive an acceptance letter and additional information regarding the following requirements:
 - a. Health History, Physical Examination, TB Skin Test and immunizations
 - b. CPR
 - c. Criminal Background Check
- Applicants who accept the offer for admission <u>must</u> attend a <u>MANDATORY Pre-</u> <u>Admission Nursing Orientation Session. Date, time, and location to be announced at</u> <u>a later date.</u>

Before Paying for these Exams you must

- 1. Take and pass ATI TEAS Exam with a minimum score of 65%
- 2. You must Setup your account with HESI at https://www.hesiinet.com
- 3. Choose the date and time you want to take the Fundamentals Exam by emailing your selection to Ms. Connie at https://www.hamptonc@mybrcc.edu. Once the exam is ordered you will be given instructions on payment.
- 4. After successfully passing the Fundamentals you will email Ms. Connie at <u>hamptonc@mybrcc.edu</u> your test date selection for Adult 1 exam. Once the exam is ordered you will receive instructions on payment.
 - Applicants must successfully pass <u>both</u> the Nursing Fundamentals Challenge <u>and</u> Adult Nursing I Challenge exam. A score of 850 is needed on both exams. Applicants are only allowed to take these exams once per admission cycle.

NOTE: If any applicant wants to use their TEAS or challenge exam scores from a previous year, please remember to check this information on page 8 of the application. In addition, if using your TEAS Exam from ATI or other college, you must submit your score report with your application.

Driving Directions:

From West of BR (using Miss River Bridge):

Use the Nicholson Drive exit ON THE BRIDGE - at the foot of the exit look to your left and see the BRCC electronic sign Turn left at the light on Terrace Street, make one block to the left and enter the fenced parking lot

From East of BR:

Interstate 10W to I-110 North (pass up the bridge across Mississippi River)

Exit Government St. (right side exit - do not use casino exit on Govt. St. exit ramp - go to the traffic light) Left on Government St. toward downtown BR to St. Ferdinand Street (about 2 -3 miles - continue directions below) From North of BR:

Interstate 110 South toward downtown BR - exit Government Street - left exit before the Mississippi River Bridge Right on Government Street toward downtown BR to St. Ferdinand Street (about 2 -3 miles - continue directions below)

Left on St. Ferdinand St. (Frost Top Café on left - Chevron gas station at intersection - River Center & court house on right) Pass under interstate bridge at South Blvd. & ahead around curve ½ mile to BRCC on left at Julia Street Look for BRCC electronic sign - white steel building on your left - park in fenced parking lot across Julia Street Nursing & Allied Health office is on second floor to left of elevators
