2 Have a high school diploma or GED and be admitted to BRCC.

3 Achieve a grade of 70% or higher in the Surgical Technology Fundamentals course (SURT 1023).

4 Achieve a grade of 80% or higher in the Surgical Technology Fundamentals Lab (SURT 1021).

5 Possess the ability to fully comply with the Surgical Technology Core Performance Standards which include: mobility, sensory, health, cognitive, psychomotor and affective behavior skills.

6 Students admitted to the Surgical Technology program will receive additional instructions regarding program requirements that include but are not limited to: submission of personal health history, results of a physical examination, a TB skin test, various immunizations/vaccinations, a urine drug screen, a CPR certification, Criminal Background Check. A positive urine drug screen or any attempt to tamper with the specimen will disqualify an applicant and/or result in dismissal from the Surgical Technology program. Applicants who have been charged with, pled guilty or nolo contendere to, been convicted of, or committed by the student.
