

Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) **Grant Spring 2022/Summer 2022 HEERF Student** **Reporting (Quarter 4; June 30, 2022)**

What is a HEERF III Grant?

The American Rescue Plan (ARP) signed into law on March 11, 2021, gave the U.S. Department of Education funds to distribute to institutions of higher education through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF III).

The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF I, II, & HEERF III) is \$18,591,381.

- **The methodology used to determine funding.**

Pell eligible students will received \$750 and Non-Pell eligible students received \$650. All students who were enrolled at BRCC during the Spring 2022 semester were eligible to receive a grant EXCEPT for the following students:

- Workforce/Non-Credit
 - Non-Matriculating/Non-Degree Seeking/Visiting
 - Prisoners
 - High school
 - Cross enrolled students.
- **Guidance provided to students concerning HEERF emergency grants.**
