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Curriculum Plan Notes:

- ¹ Prerequisites include 1) Either a minimum ACT Composite score of 22 or both BIOL 120 and 120L with grades of "C" or better, AND 2) eligibility for college math. Both conditions (1) and (2) must be met to satisfy this course's prerequisite requirement
- ² Prerequisite includes BIOL 230 with a grade of "C" or better
- ³ Prerequisite includes PSYC 201 with a grade of "C" or better
- ⁴ Prerequisite includes appropriate placement test score or ENGL 091
- ⁵ MATH 101 provides a five-hour class equivalent to MATH 110 which meets the needs of students requiring additional class time to succeed. Prerequisite includes appropriate placement test score or MATH 094 (with a grade of C or higher) or MATH 100 (with a grade of C or higher)
- ⁶ Students must select one Fine Arts elective AND one Humanities elective. Fine Arts elective may be selected from ART (101, 102, 103), FILM (200, 201), MUSC (101, 102), OR THTR (100). Humanities elective may be selected from ENGL (210, 211, 215, 220, 221, 222, 223, 230, 240, 248), FREN (101, 102, 201, 202), GERM (101), HIST (101, 101H, 102, 200, 201, 202, 221, 222), HUMN (210, 250, 255, 275), ITAL (101), PHIL (201, 203, 205, 228), SPAN (101, 102, 201, 202), OR SPCH (101, 120, 210, 220, 240, 263).
- ⁷ Prerequisites include BIOL 230, PSYC 201, ENGL 101, AND MATH 101/110 with grades of "C" or better, AND admission to the nursing program
- ⁸ Prerequisites include NURS 110, BIOL 231, AND PSYC 202 with grades of "C" or better
- ⁹ Prerequisites include NURS 110 AND BIOL 231 with grades of "C" or better
- ¹⁰ Prerequisites include 1) either a minimum ACT Composite score of 22 or both BIOL 120 and 120L with grades of "C" or better eligibility for college math, AND 2) eligibility for college math. Both conditions (1) and (2) must be met to satisfy this course's prerequisite requirement
- ¹¹ Prerequisites include NURS 210, NURS 212, AND BIOL 210 with grades of "C" or better
- ¹² Prerequisites include NURS 210, NURS 212, AND PSYC 202 with grades of "C" or better
- ¹³ Prerequisite includes ENGL 101 with a grade of "C" or better
- ¹⁴ Prerequisites include NURS 220 AND 222 with grades of "C" or better
- ¹⁵ Prerequisite includes either 1) an appropriate mathematics placement score, OR 2) MATH 101, 110, or 120 with a grade of "C" or better

Admission Criteria:

- Admission to the ASN program LPN to RN Entry Track is competitive.
- It is important to note that simply meeting the requirements for admission to the nursing program does not guarantee admission.
- Applicants must have a grade of "C" or better in the 23 credit hours of required prerequisite courses.
- Applicants must be a graduate of an approved LPN program.
- Applicants must hold an unencumbered license as a practical nurse in the state of Louisiana.
- Applicants must receive a passing score on both the Nursing Fundamentals and Adult Nursing I challenge examination.

Application Process:

- LPN to RN Track Application becomes available on the BRCC website in December and is due January 12. Notification of admittance is sent in June. Classes would begin the following August.
- Applications must be submitted in person to the Nursing & Allied Health Department, 2nd Floor Frazier Campus.
- Students will register for the HESI Nursing Entrance Exam when applications are submitted.

Section Notification:

- All students will be notified whether admitted or not admitted to nursing program in June.
- Admitted students must also attain/submit the following: CPR: AHA CPR for healthcare providers, drug screen, comprehensive physical exam, AND criminal background check.

Additional Information:

- Hours transferred from other colleges must be approved by the Office of Enrollment Services or the Nursing & Allied Health Department.
- Students who successfully challenge Nursing Fundamentals and Adult Nursing I will receive 12 credit hours which will be reflected in the total curriculum hours.
